The Waukesha Kennel club, Inc. offers two \$200.00 Freshman Scholarships to students who plan to do college work leading to a degree in a field of biological science. High School Seniors who are residents of Waukesha County, who are attending high school in or out of Waukesha County, or who are homeschooled students, are eligible to apply for the scholarship. The requirements for receiving subsequent annual grants of \$300.00, \$700.00 and \$800.00 for a total of \$2000.00 include:

- Continuing biological science as a major field of study.
- Maintaining a 2.5 grade point (on a 4.0 basis) or its equivalent each school year.
- Re-applying prior to August 1st.

Selection of the student to whom this scholarship will be awarded will be made by a committee representing the Waukesha Kennel Club, Inc. The committee will consider:

- Interest displayed in the field of biological science which includes, among others, human or veterinary medicine, genetics, science education, biochemistry, marine biology, forestry, agriculture, and wildlife management.
- Scholastic achievement, including standardized test scores and transcripts.
- Community standing as evidenced by personal references. Two letters of recommendation should accompany the application.
